The meeting began with Mayor Roger Weatherwax making Council aware that Jackie Burch would be inquiring about approval to purchase a mower for the Park. Jackie Burch wasn't present for the meeting and Council questioned if there had already been a mower purchased for the park earlier this year. Mayor Weatherwax informed them that they had bought one for the Golf Course but not the Park but Deroma Pepper will check records and get back to Council with a definite answer on purchases that had been made.

The second item that was up for discussion was the employee insurance. Each year we generally see an increase and as usual if the City keeps the same plan we currently have there will be an increase in premiums. Deroma Pepper, City Clerk had presented information in the previous meeting to the Council on cost for the current plan and also for a second option which could save the City and possibly employee some cost but some differences were in the plans, mainly the deductibles. Jason White suggested that the City pay all the cost of employee only plan and looking at the City paying 60% on other options and the employees paying the remaining 40%. The Council Members will be given a breakdown of all cost for each option under the suggestion made by Jason White and a decision will be made at next council meeting.

Denise Lovett had posed the question of the sign ordinance and ordinances in general as to who was the initial contact person when something needed to be enforced. Mayor Weatherwax informed her to speak to Mr. Saint or direct anyone with questions to him and if necessary the law enforcement would be contacted if the circumstances required intervention by them. Old signs were a topic that many of the Council have had problems with and the Mayor advised them that he could talk to the Street Department and ask if while they were out if they would take down any signs that were not in compliance or out of date.

Joyce Jeffreys ask if the Park Project was getting progress done and also about possibly looking into completing the entire project so that it could be utilized sooner than later or if the sewer project needed more concentration. Mayor Weatherwax said the weather had postponed some of the progress on the

ball park but they were working at it. More discussion will be needed on the direction the Council wants to go with the park construction or the needed sewer rehab because both are in stages that will soon need consideration before moving forward with either.
