Mark Heflin with the sewer treatment plant presented to the Council his request for materials for upgrades to the plant and also for a Skid to put the piece of equipment on that is a press he obtained from another Treatment Plant and a very small cost to the City. Mark gave a very in depth explanation also of an engineering firm that he is in contact with that can provide the City with a Flow Study that will also benefit the problems that are being faced at the lagoon. All of the information that Mark provided to the Council was received well as to the cost and also for him to continue as necessary to look at the best ways to cost efficiently handle the plant. If the Council approves the materials for the upgrades and improvements – Mark will be able to do the upgrades and repairs to the plant without more expense to the City.

Mayor Weatherwax said they are still considering the painting, bathroom & shingles at the parks and other upgrades while continuing to look into cost to do those improvements.

The Water Department had requested in the 2018 Budget to purchase a Mini-Excavator and Trailer and will be presenting the Council with those figures at the next meeting.

Mayor Weatherwax also ask that the Council go over any information and questions that they have concerning the Budget for 2018-2019 prior to the next meeting in hopes of coming to an agreement and be able to pass the Budget at that meeting.
