Stacey Givens presented Council with a proposal for the spraying of the parks for mosquitos again this year – in his proposal he gave was for approximately 44 acres at a cost of \$658.00 treatment would begin in April/May and continue until first frost.

Beverly Harvey spoke to Council about some property she owns and would like for Council to recommend as a prime place for a hotel to locate if the opportunity comes along it is 2.8 acres with Byler Rd, Morgan St & Hwy 157 frontage.

Paul Burkhalter – came and spoke to Council concerning the Byler Road East Tap Project which will go from Pinhook to Moulton Village. After discussion with Council over the plans Mr. Burkhalter expressed that he didn't see any problems with preceding with the next steps for this project. Council Members ask that the Utilities Supervisors look at the plans to insure that there would be no unexpected cost in their departments for such things as relocating etc.

Mayor Weatherwax spoke to Council about possibly looking into buying new trucks at the State Bid and implementing a rotation type program so that the cost of maintenance and fuel would go down and older vehicles would be eliminated due to the expense incurred to maintain.

An update was briefly given to Council on letters sent out on properties and also properties being posted due to not complying with earlier request. A more detailed list will be given at regular Council Meeting by the Building Inspector.

The Water Treatment Plant had a generator damaged in recent storms and the expense could be over \$10,000.00 and will be brought to Council for approval at which time repairs are made but this has also been submitted to our insurance company and it should cover most of the expense.

The League of Municipalities is holding its Annual Conference in Mobile and the Mayor ask if anyone was going to attend to be sure and let Deroma Pepper know so that accommodations could be made. After posing the question no one at this time is going to planning on attending.
