The meeting was opened with a call from RSA to explain the Tier I and Tier II options that need to be voted on. They are not doing on site consultations due to the COVID-19 so they arranged to call in. Several employees had questions that were ask of the representative and answered. Some of the Council also posed questions in regards to how the program was going to work. The finalization came down to that the Tier II employees could get the benefits of the Tier I employees at a cost to them and the City but if a decision wasn't made in a timely manner then the City would not be able to make this selection at a later date. The Tier I employees would not be affected in anyway by this change unless the City became financially unable to pay which is a very unlikely thing to happen. Tier II current employees pay 6% and FLC employees pay 7% their contribution would change to 7 ½% for regular and 8 ½% for FLC employees and all benefits that are outlined for the Tier I employees would also be extended to the Tier II employees.

Our auditor Jeremy Jeffreys was present to answer questions on the financial situation of the City. With two big projects on the table needing to be completed the questions were posed to whether or not the City could move forward on both. Mr. Jeffreys said he felt like the City was in good shape and that it could handle moving forward on the sidewalk "East Project" on Byler Rd and also borrow money to finish the ballfields at the H. A. Alexander Park. He said he would like to see the budget figures for the upcoming year even though it was determined that the COVID-19 hadn't impacted the City as much as some there is always the latter effects such as business license being down etc. that could have some economic impact on the City's revenue.

The Sidewalk project on Byler Rd "East" will Prebid on July 23<sup>rd</sup> and be opened on July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020. This information was given to Mayor Weatherwax by the engineering firm.

Park and Recreation is having games played at this time following the CDC guidelines. The New Ballfields are being requested but need more work before they can be opened for play but the light poles are being addressed at this time and will be installed soon.

Emily Edwards will be meeting with supervisors in the coming week on budget and then on July 13<sup>th</sup> she has ask that the Supervisors be present at that Work Session to present and talk to the Council about budget items for the upcoming year.
