

Rules and Regulations for Moulton Memorial Gardens

(Amend Upright Sections to include Triple Monument Height)
(Opening and closing done only by agents of the City of Moulton)

The cemetery reserves the right to compel all persons coming into the cemetery to obey all rules and regulations adopted by the City of Moulton. The rules and regulations may be changed without notice to any owners by the City Council.

- All maintenance on lots, other than mausoleum will be done by the City of Moulton, under the direction of City of Moulton. All grading, fill-ins, sodding, landscaping, mowing, improvements of any kind, and all openings and closing of lots shall be done only by an agent of the City of Moulton.
- Grave Markings:
 - Upright Section: Triple (Section S Only - No wider than 18 inches, no longer than 108 inches, and no higher than 30”
Triple (All upright sections except Section S) – No wider than 18 inches, no longer than 108 inches and no higher than 38”
Double - No wider than 18 inches, no longer than 72 inches, and no higher than 30 inches.
Single – No wider than 18 inches, no longer than 36 inches, and no higher than 30 inches.
 - Flat Section: Double - Restricted and limited to flat bronze or granite markers set flush with the ground, no wider than 18 inches, and no longer than 96 inches. Only one sub-surface vase will be allowed.
Single - Restricted and limited to flat bronze or granite markers set flush with the ground, no wider than 18 inches, and no longer than 48 inches. Only one sub-surface vase will be allowed.
- Outer receptacles, such as a vault will be required.
- Only one increment per grave will be allowed, with the exception of cremations. Only two cremations per grave will be allowed.
- In order that the cemetery may always present neat and orderly appearance as possible, cut or artificial flowers may be used to decorate graves at any time, provided they are either: Placed in approved sub-surface vases, or clamped securely to the headstone. Flowers should in no way be anchored to the ground. Grave decorations of any other description, other than those provided within, shall not be permitted, and will be removed and destroyed.
- Fresh and silk flower removal should take place seven (7) days following a funeral. The cemetery staff will remove these flowers unless removed ahead of time by family.
- The City is not responsible for any theft or damage to anything placed on lots.
- Any company or business having a current business license with the City of Moulton will be allowed to set markers or tombstones, provided that it is done with a 24 hour notice and under supervision of cemetery management. Failure to abide by this, or failure to properly install monuments, will result in termination of license.
- A 24-hour notice is required on all grave openings.
- The City will display a United States Flag at the cemetery, in a designated section, to honor all for their gifts and contributions to our country.
- The sale or transfer of any full or partial lot shall not be valid or recognized until the proper documentation has been presented to the Cemetery Department and the transaction approved by the director.
