Purpose of the meeting is to Canvass Votes from the recent run-off election on September 23, 2005.

Emily Edwards the election manager stated that there were 4 provisional votes and that only 2 of those votes were verified/approved by the Board of Registers to be valid and that they were both in District 3. Ms. Edwards opened the sealed box with those votes in the presence of the Council and those present at the Council Meeting. Once opened the envelopes inside holding the ballots were read aloud the first vote going to Mayor – Roger Weatherwax and the 2nd vote going to Mayor – Roger Weatherwax that would bring the total votes for Roger Weatherwax to 276 votes.

With a tie between the 2 lowest bidders, it was left for the Council to decide which bidder to go with. Denise Lovett commented that CDI was the contractor that tore the previous building down on the square and had to leave a wall standing. She stated that they would understand the integrity or lack there of since they had worked in that area already. Mayor Weatherwax stated that they had proven themselves in doing that work. Cassandra Lee made a Motion to use C & C Land Clearing because she had saw the work they did on Rosenwald, and they did it efficiently and cleaned up well in that endeavor.
