- 1) Chip Proctor \$65,000.00 per yr \$1,250.00 weekly (Pkt was incomplete
* No License & No Insurance.)
- 2) Integrity Landscaping & Lawncare \$59,820.00 per yr \$1,300.00 weekly (Complete Pkg)
- 3) Thorn's Lawn \$80,000.00 per yr \$2,051.28 weekly (Pkt was incomplete
*No Business License but did have Insurance)
- 4) Fresh Cut Services \$64,000.00 per yr \$1,600.00 weekly (Pkt was incomplete
*No Business License but did have Insurance)
- 5) TGB \$67,200.00 per yr \$2,100.00 weekly (Complete Pkg)

After much discussion and some confusion voiced by TGB owner on how the bid was to have been made and by Integrity owner as to his understanding of the bid packet and his process for bidding Council proceeded to vote on the bids received as they were received with only 2 bids having complete packets those being Integrity Landscaping & Lawncare and TGB.
