Mayor Jolly opened meeting with pledge of allegiance and prayer.

Public Hearing was opened for the purpose of hearing any citizen concerns for or against the request from Costa Del Marlin Mexican Restaurant for a restaurant liquor license. There being no one present to speak in favor or against this licensing, the Public Hearing was closed.

Resolution 2026-005 approving Retail off Premise Beer and Wine License to Dolencorp, LLC dba Dollar General #31197 located at 13873 Market St., Moulton, AL 35650 was presented to Council.

Mayor Jolly called for a roll-call vote on this Resolution 2026-005.

Roll Call: Danny Morris – No, Jason White – Yes, Mayor Jolly – No, Tate Gille – Not Present at time of Vote, Cassandra Lee – Yes, and Chris Proctor – No

Mayor Jolly stated that with the vote being 3 – “No’s” and 2 – “Yes’s” that the Resolution for Dollar General to be licensed for off premise sales of beer and wine was denied and it failed by a vote of 3 to 2.

Council had been contemplating changing the employee health insurance due to increases in premiums from Blue Cross Blue Shield to Local Government Insurance. Mayor Jolly told Council that the employee meeting went well and that the majority of employees were in favor of the change to Local Government and that the differences in deductibles and benefits were all minor and, in most cases, better with the Local Government Insurance.

Retiree Option was discussed and the percentages were not at this time agreed upon. Mayor Jolly ask that Council consider the 75/25 percentage with the retiree paying 75% and City paying 25% and it could be decided on later.

The fire department was asking Council to approve \$10,000.00 extra in order to make up the difference in the cost of a fire truck that was found to purchase. Councilman Proctor ask where the funds would be coming from to cover this – Mayor Jolly responded that it would come from the General Fund.
