Meeting was opened by Mayor Jolly.

A representative from Local Government Health Insurance Board named Jason Graham was present at the meeting to discuss insurance coverage. Mayor Ryan Jolly asked questions about the difference in this insurance coverage and our current insurance plan. Mr. Graham went over several differences including: pharmaceutical coverages, copays on labs, deductible decrease, monthly fee decrease, hospital copay decreases, additional visits for chiropractors.

Mayor Ryan Jolly explained the differences in premiums in both insurances. The new plan would be a savings for the city of approximately \$38,368.68 annually. The employee would also pay a decreased monthly rate for family coverage. Mr. Graham explained how similar the insurances are and how the process works for medication reimbursement.

Mayor Jolly also told the Council the LGHIB insurance offers a retiree option for employees who have been employed with the City for at least 10 years. There is a single coverage offered for \$1,349.00 monthly. He wanted the council to keep this option in mind and would like to be able to offer this to employees.

Mayor Ryan Jolly asked the council for a motion to go into back into regular session, and Councilman Jason White made the motion. Councilwoman Cassandra Lee seconded his motion. All council voted in favor of the motion.

Mayor Jolly asked the council if they had any questions. Councilman Danny Morris asked additional questions about the pharmaceutical reimbursements and which drugs were considered tier 2-4 drugs. He also asked about the mail order for tier 4 drugs and Mr. Graham said the tier 4 drugs could only be mail ordered and gave a list of tier 2-4 drugs for example. Mayor Jolly asked the Council to review the materials they were given and if they have any questions or concerns let him know and we will get answers for them.

Mayor Jolly closed the meeting.
